

## Quilted Pocketbook with Long or Short Handle



### Supply List and Fabric Needed

**Fat quarters work great for this project**

**4-5 fat quarters for your squares**

**1 fat quarter for sides and bottom**

**2 fat quarters for lining**

**1 Fat Quarter for you bias strips around Top edge**

**1 fat quarter for card holder (optional)**

**Use leftovers from side and bottom for inside pockets**

**1/8 yd X 42 inches for handle**

### Cut

- 2 12 ½ inch patchwork or appliquéd squares made and ready for class
- 6 2 ½ inch x 12 ½ inch pieces in same or contrasting fabrics, bottom & sides
- 2 17 ½ inch x 17 ½ inch rectangles in the same or contrasting fabrics, lining
- 3 12 ½ inch x 6 inch rectangles of the same or contrasting fabrics, inside pockets
- 3 4 inch x 22 inch strips same or contrasting colors, for card holders
- 1 Bias strip that measures 1 ½ inches x 36 inches, in the same color fabric as in the 12 ½ inch square or a contrasting color
- 1 11/8 yd. (9inches) x 40 inches (full width of fabric) for you handle

Choose one

#### For short handle

- 2 4 ½ x 15 inch strips of same or contrasting fabrics

#### For long handle

- 1 4 ½ x 30 inch of same or contrasting fabrics

- 2 17 x 14 ½ inch piece of batting
  - 2 17 x 14 ½ inches of muslin
  - 1 Piece of belt webbing (17 inch for short handle) or (36 inch piece for long handle)
  - 2 2 inch plastic rings that are on piece
- Matching threads to piece your pocketbook  
Contrasting thread to quilt your pocketbook

Sewing machine with drop feed dogs is recommended and have your machine in running order. Well oiled machines work better.

\*You can use a straight stitch machine and stitch in the ditch and quilt diagonal quilting stitches if you want, it may take you longer.
