

Star Trick Table Runner

It is surprisingly easy and fast to make this lovely Star block.
 Finished Size Table Runner: 14.5" x 42.5".
 Finished Block Size: 10" square



Fabric Requirements

Light (background)	1/2 yard
Dark red	1/4 yard
Red	1/4 yard
Dark green	1/8 yard
Green	1/8 yard
Golden yellow accent	1/4 yard

Backing Fabric: 45" x 18" piece

Binding Fabric: $\frac{1}{4}$ yards

Batting: 45" x 18" piece of cotton batting

Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat, Glue-stick, marking pencil

Neutral 100% cotton thread, Scissors, Threads to match red fabrics for top-stitching. Sewing machine in good working order.

1. Cutting Instructions:

Fabrics	No. of strips to cut	Sub cut strips into:
Light (background)	1 - 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (cut from remaining strip)	1 - 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square *(setting triangles) 24 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
Dark red	1 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip	12 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, folded
Red	1 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip	12 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, folded
Dark green	1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (cut from remaining strip)	6 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips 6 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, folded
Green	1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (cut from remaining strip)	6 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips 6 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, folded
Golden yellow	1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip	3 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
Binding	3 - 2" strips	3 - 2" strips
Backing $\frac{1}{2}$ yard		1 - 18" x 44" piece
Batting $\frac{1}{2}$ yard		1 - 18" x 44" piece
